### Child Find for Programs for Exceptional Children

**Special Education** - Special programs for disabled children are provided in accordance with IDEA. Child Find is an attempt to locate and provide appropriate educational and related services to all disabled children between the ages birth and 21. If you are a parent of a disabled child who is not receiving services, contact the Homewood Board of Education (205) 870-4203.

**Gifted** - Gifted students are those who perform at or who have demonstrated the potential to perform at high levels in academic or creative fields when compared to others of their age, experience, or environment. These students require services not ordinarily provided by the regular school program. Any individual with knowledge of the student's abilities may refer a student. Additionally, all second grade students will be observed as potential gifted referrals using a gifted behavior checklist.
